Excorp Medical, Inc. Announces Expert's Forum in Beijing

Excorp Medical, Inc. has received notification that an "Experts Forum" dedicated to the discussion of its bioartificial liver will be conducted October 23, 2009 in Beijing, China. The Forum is expected to be led by the China International Medical Foundation and consist of experts in Microbiology, Liver research, hepatobiliary surgery, and medical associations from prestigious Peking University, Beijing Friendship Hospital and Second Military Medical University. A representative from the SFDA (China's FDA) and a medical statistics expert are expected to participate.

According to the October – December 2009 Issue of Liver Health Today (www.liverhealthtoday.org), published by the Hepatitis Support Association, sixty percent of people in China have a history of hepatitis B. One person dies every 30 seconds in China of liver failure making it the number 2 killer in China.

The Forum will offer their opinions on the technology and its utility in China which is expected to be favorable, establishing the path for regulatory approval.
